ORDER RELATING TO ORAL ARGUMENT


The Petitioner is granted a total of 30 minutes for oral argument. A portion of the time may be reserved for rebuttal. See Supreme Court Rule 7.01(e)(3) (2020 Kan. S. Ct. R. 42) (reserving rebuttal time).

Respondents are granted 30 minutes and will argue after the Petitioner's initial argument. See Supreme Court Rule 7.01(e)(5) (2020 Kan. S. Ct. R. 42) (multiple parties).

The clerk of the appellate courts will provide counsel with logistical information and instructions related to the videoconference.
