Amended Order on Relocation of Thomas County District Court Offices

This order amends 2021-CC-107 to update the dates the Thomas County District Court may close to relocate to its new facility. This order also adds dates when electronic processes will be unavailable.

Pursuant to K.S.A. 20-101, and amendments thereto, K.S.A. 20-319, and amendments thereto, and K.S.A. 20-347, and amendments thereto, this court authorizes the 15th Judicial District to take the following actions:

- The Thomas County District Court may relocate from temporary offices at 1105 Taylor Avenue, Colby, Kansas to the new Thomas County Justice Center at 275 N. Court Avenue, Colby, Kansas.
- All Thomas County District Court functions and offices may continue operations at the temporary offices until the Thomas County District Court has relocated to its new facility.
- All Thomas County District Court offices may close on September 13 through September 14, 2021, for the purpose of moving to the new facility, and resume operations at the new facility on September 15, 2021.
- From September 10, 2021, at 5 p.m. until September 14, 2021, at 5 p.m., all electronic processes will be unavailable in the Thomas County Clerk's Office. This includes the Kansas eFiling System for the electronic filing of documents and the CitePay system for making payments with a credit card, electronic check, or other electronic method. During this time, attorneys will be allowed to file by facsimile except when telephone lines are down to switch service.
- During the time the Kansas Courts eFiling system is unavailable from 5 p.m. September 10, 2021, until 5 p.m. on September 14, 2021, Kansas Supreme Court Rule 122(e)(1) (2021 Kan. S. Ct. R. 210) will allow an attorney to seek relief from the court if a filing is untimely due to unavailability of the system.

- Effective at 5:00 p.m. on September 14, 2021, electronic processes in the Thomas County District Court will be available. The Kansas Courts eFiling system will be available for electronic filing of documents and the electronic payment system will be operational for making payments with a credit card, electronic check, or other electronic method.

This order amends and supersedes 2021-CC-107.
