Re: Calendar Year 1982 Holidays


Pursuant to Section 8.9 of the Kansas Court Personnel Rules, the following dates have been approved for the 1982 holidays:

| Washington's Birthday | Monday, February 15, 1982                                |
| Memorial Day          | Monday, May 31, 1982                                     |
| Independence Day      | Monday, July 5, 1982                                     |
| Labor Day             | Monday, September 6, 1982                                |
| Veterans Day          | Thursday, November 11, 1982                              |
| Thanksgiving Day      | Thursday, November 25, 1982<br>Friday, November 26, 1982 |
| Christmas             | Friday, December 24, 1982                                |
| New Year's Day        | Friday, December 31, 1982                                |

Provided, however, that the courts in any county must remain open on any day when the local county courthouse is open for business, and such courts may take as a holiday any day on which the local county courthouse is closed by official order of the board of county commissioners.

Observance of these holidays by a district court may be deferred whenever observance of the holiday would interfere with judicial proceedings in progress.
