Re: Calendar Year 1997 Holidays

Pursuant to K.S.A. 35-107, Section 9.10 of the Kansas Court Personnel Rules, and the executive memorandum issued by Governor Bill Graves on June 10, 1996, the following dates have been approved for 1997 holidays:


New Year's Day	Wednesday, January 1, 1997
Martin Luther King, Jr. Day	Monday, January 20, 1997
President's Day	Monday, February 17, 1997
Memorial Day	Monday, May 26, 1997
Independence Day	Friday, July 4, 1997
Labor Day	Monday, September 1, 1997
Columbus Day	*Monday, October 13, 1997
Veterans Day	Tuesday, November 11, 1997
Thanksgiving Day	Thursday, November 27, 1997 Friday, November 28, 1997
Christmas	Thursday, December 25, 1997

Observance of these holidays by a district court may be deferred whenever observance of the holiday would interfere with judicial proceedings in progress.

At the discretion of the administrative judge and approval of the Judicial Administrator, a district court may remain open on any of the above-designated holidays when the local county courthouse is open for business and observe as a substitute holiday a county designated holiday not otherwise observed by the Judicial Branch.

*Whereas traditional observance of Columbus Day falls on Saturday, October 11, 1997 and the official observance of this holiday is declared by K.S.A. 35-108 to be the second Monday in October, observance of this holiday shall be recognized on Monday, October 13, 1997.
