ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 166

Re: Kansas Elders and the Law Week

The week commencing with the first Monday in October of 2001 and each consecutive year is hereby designated as "Kansas Elders and the Law Week." This coincides with the opening session of the United States Supreme Court.

Kansas Elders and the Law Week is a joint effort by the Kansas Judicial Branch, the Kansas Department on Aging, and the Kansas Bar Association, to build awareness of issues confronting our aging population and provide information to our elder citizens, as well as their families and caregivers.

Events will be held in local courthouses in an effort to introduce community members to the court system and their program content will be determined locally. Each District Court location is encouraged to participate.
