Pursuant to K.S.A. 35–107, Section 8.9 of the Kansas Court Personnel Rules and the executive memorandum issued by Governor Mark Parkinson on June 15, 2010, the following dates have been approved for calendar year 2011 holidays:

New Year's Day Friday, December 31, 2010 Martin Luther King, Jr. Day Monday, January 17, 2011 Presidents Day Monday, February 21, 2011 Memorial Day Monday, May 30, 2011 Independence Day Monday, July 4, 2011 Labor Day Monday, September 5, 2011 Columbus Day Monday, October 10, 2011 Veterans Day Friday, November 11, 2011 Thanksgiving Day Thursday, November 24, 2011 Friday, November 25, 2011 Monday, December 26, 2011 Christmas Day

Observance of these holidays by a district court may be deferred whenever observance of the holiday would interfere with judicial proceedings in progress.

At the discretion of the chief judge and approval of the judicial administrator, a district court may remain open on any of the above–designated holidays when the local county courthouse is open for business and observe as a substitute holiday a county designated holiday not otherwise observed by the Judicial Branch.
