RULE 6.01

TIME SCHEDULE FOR BRIEFS

Supreme Court Rule 6.01 is hereby amended, effective the date of this order:

All briefs shall be served upon opposing counsel, and thereafter filed with the clerk of the appellate courts, according to the following schedule:

(a) Appellant's Brief

If a reporter's transcript was not ordered or if the transcript was ordered and has been completed prior to docketing, within forty (40) days after the date of docketing. If a transcript was ordered, within thirty (30) days after service of the certificate of filing of the transcript in accordance with Rule 3.03.

If a record on appeal includes the statement of proceedings made pursuant to Rule 3.04, or the agreed statement pursuant to Rule 3.05, within thirty (30) days after the filing thereof with the clerk of the district court.

- (b) Appellee's Brief (and Cross-Appellant's Brief)
 Within thirty (30) days after service of the appellant's brief.
- (c) Cross-Appellee's Brief
 Within twenty (20) days after service of the cross-appellant's brief.
- (d) Appellee/Cross-Appellee's Brief
 Within twenty (20) days after service of the appellee/cross-appellant's brief.
- (d) (e) Reply Brief
 Within fifteen (15) days after service of the brief to which the reply is made.
