ADMISSION TO THE BAR BY UNIFORM BAR EXAMINATION SCORE

Rule 709A is hereby amended, effective the date of the order.

....

(c) An applicant may file a verified application for admission under this rule any time after the applicant has filed an application to sit for the next administration of the UBE in another UBE jurisdiction.

(d)(e) The provisions of Rules 715, 716, 717, 718 and 721 apply to applicants under this rule.

(e)(d) Any application returned to the applicant due to deficiencies, pursuant to Rule 713, will not be considered as timely filed.

(f)(e) When an application under this rule has been considered and approved by the office of the Disciplinary Administrator, the Review Committee, or the Board, the applicant after providing proof of education as required in Rule 706, will be permitted to take the oath before the Clerk of the Appellate Courts and sign the roll of attorneys. The Clerk shall thereafter issue applicant a certificate of authority to practice law in this State.
