## **ORDER**

Re: Committee on Consolidation

Pursuant to our authority under Article 3, Section 1 of the Kansas Constitution, we hereby create the Supreme Court Committee on Consolidation to:

- Examine whether adult and juvenile offender supervision services in Kansas currently
  performed by both court services officers and community corrections officers should
  be consolidated, and if so, how;
- Consider options including, but not limited to, continuation of the current system, consolidation into court services, consolidation into community corrections, and consolidation into a new agency;
- 3. Consider how supervision is addressed in other states including, but not limited to, whether supervision is performed by one entity or by multiple entities, and whether the services are provided by the judicial branch, the executive branch, by local government, or in some other manner. Research should include obtaining input from the Kansas Department of Corrections and community corrections;
- Consider service, financial, and staffing impacts;
- 5. Consider any other matters that may be relevant to the issue of consolidation including, but not limited to, prior legislation such as 2016 Senate Bill 503.
- 6. Make judgments which use each member's experience and knowledge but which are based on achieving the best outcome for the state as a whole;
- 7. Develop a recommendation for the Supreme Court; and
- 8. Deliver its report to the Court no later than November 29, 2016.
